### ACTIVITY INTRODUCTION

### CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

#### OBJECTIVES (What do we want to achieve)

Common to all three trimesters:

- Encourage the interest of learning English
- Hello and goodbye
- Respond to new vocabulary with mime, visual recognition, gestures, etc..
- Listen responsively to stories
- Sing and perform songs
- Play simple words and phrases
- Work on English phonetics

#### CONTENT (What activities are we going to do)

1st quarter:

- Getting to know and learning from animals, colors, body parts and numbers
- Work phonetics and pronunciation through songs and stories

2nd quarter

- Getting to know and learning from members of the family, home, tastes (I like, I do not like), food, time
- Recognize and use the expressions: What is it? It is a ...,
- Work with phonetics and pronunciation through songs and stories

3rd quarter

- Getting to know and learning the feelings (I feel ...), leisure activities (ride a bike, play football, etc ...), the days of the week, seasons, adjectives of description (big, small, fat, thin , etc.)
- Work phonetics and pronunciation through songs and stories

#### METHODOLOGY (How will we do this)

Through the use of stories, songs and games we will teach children to work in English.



Both, the teachers and the group are required to interact in English to accomplish this goal.
